Personal Conduct

Nisa-Nashim members will

1. Contribute to and take responsibility for respectful, harmonious, safe, productive, kind spaces, including within our groups
2. Not bring Nisa-Nashim into disrepute by actions or activities
3. Support and contribute to the Nisa-Nashim mission

Beliefs and Values

Nisa-Nashim members

1. Understand and respect what other members believe and value (within the law), expressed in their own terms, regardless of religion, race, sexual orientation, disability, age or geography
2. Believe in and support the unique role of women as leaders
3. Respect the convictions of others about food, dress and social etiquette and not behave or speak in ways which cause offence
4. Recognise that there are many interpretations of our own traditions and not compare our own ideals with other people's practices
5. Recognise that listening is necessary for a genuine conversation
6. Work to prevent disagreement leading to conflict
7. Correct misunderstanding or misrepresentations not only of our own but also of other faiths
8. Refrain from trying to religiously convert others

Confidentiality

Members will not

1. Represent their own views as the views of Nisa-Nashim to third parties
2. Disclose information which by its nature is confidential and which has been acquired through their role, other than where proper authorisation has been given;
3. Misuse information acquired through their role for personal or commercial gain for themselves, their organisations or anyone else

Conflict of interest

Members will ensure that personal or financial interests do not conflict with their ability to perform their role; and manage and declare any conflict between their personal and public duties as a member
